There will be 9-Hole Competitions over the winter for those ladies who wish to play competitively on the above days. **On Tuesdays and Sundays** you can play at any time of the day with whoever you wish and sign up on BRS as normal.

For all 9-Hole Competitions i.e. Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays, you need to sign the book pertinent to the day you are playing. There will be a separate book for each day, these will be on the desk in the Ladies' Locker Room clearly labelled with the playing day. Place your entry fee of £1 in an envelope clearly labelled with your name and date and put in the Ladies' Competition Box. Please note that once the short 6th and 9th winter tees are in play you must only use the Winter 9-Hole Competition score cards.

After your round please place your signed card in the **Ladies'** Competition Box in the locker room.

<u>Arrangements for THURSDAY Morning Golf - Starting 2nd November 2023</u>

Angela Hunt is once again organising the Thursday social golf this year. Ladies should sign up on **BRS in our blocked booked time** (Thursdays 10am-11am) by 4.30 p.m. on the Wednesday evening before. This will **not** be your tee time, this simply indicates that you wish to play 9 holes on the following Thursday morning.

Angela will then sort ladies into playing groups, probably groups of 3 depending on numbers, and allocate each group a tee time **which will be emailed to everyone by 8.30pm on Wednesday evening** – so please check your emails i.e. you will play at the tee time that Angela emails to you **not** the time you have signed up on BRS.

The purpose of the above arrangement is to enable us to meet up and play with different lady members each week.

If, after you have received your allotted tee time from Angela, you decide **not to play** please let your allotted playing partners know - Do not contact Angela.

There will be a 9-Hole Competition every Thursday, but the 10.00 - 11.00 a.m. blocked tee time is for **all** ladies whether or not you wish to play the actual 9-Hole Competition. There is no compulsion to play in the competition when you sign up in our block booking, but please let Angela know if you are playing but **not** in the competition.

All the 9-Hole Competitions are non-qualifiers, so do not count towards your handicap. However each time you win the Thursday competition you will be docked one shot from your course/playing handicap. This does **not** apply to Tuesdays and Sundays where you will keep your normal playing handicap through the winter.

Please note that a £5 M and S voucher will be presented to the winner after play on Thursdays, provided that a minimum of 5 ladies have played, otherwise for less than 5 players a ball will be presented. Prizes for Tuesdays and Sundays will be given out to winners at some point after the competitions are played.
